Recycling paper helps to protect the environment by:

- Saving forests
- Reducing greenhouse gas emissions
- Saving energy
- Saving water
- Reducing landfill



Each year, Shred-it® customers with a regularly-scheduled service can request a certificate detailing the number of trees they saved.

1

Confidential documents are dropped into a secure, locked container.

2

On a scheduled basis, containers are emptied and all confidential documents are destroyed. 3

A certificate of destruction is issued to each customer.

4

Shredded paper is transported to a paper mill for recycling. 5

Pulp is made as the fibres of the shredded paper are separated. 6

The pulp is put through a screening process that filters out impurities and prepares it for the removal of printing ink.

7

The newly recycled pulp is mixed with fresh pulp to manufacture new paper products.
